“Embrace The Gift of Life” is an annual charity project initiated by Shangri-La Kuala Lumpur since 1985 to support children with severe heart ailments and other serious medical conditions. To date, Shangri-La Kuala Lumpur has raised over RM4 million and helped hundreds of critically ill children through this charity project.

This year, the Hotel's chosen theme is The Shangri-La Kuala Lumpur Express. Six colour variation of trains ornaments will occupy ten tiers of rotating conical steel structure on the giant Christmas Tree located at Main Lobby.

These hand-crafted ornaments reflect the colours of happiness and wonders of life, symbolising the hope we bring to children with serious ailments as well as the chance to live a fulfilling life post-surgery. Each ornament is artfully designed by our pastry team, led by Pastry Artist Chef Wayne Siow.

We would like to invite you and your organization to support this annual fund-raising charity project by sponsoring one or more ornaments with a minimum donation of RM1,000 per set. The donor's name or company logo will be displayed below each set of ornaments.

**One year old Nor Jannah** was born with Patent Ductus Arteriosus (PDA), a condition where she has an extra blood vessel. As a result, too much blood flows into the lungs, which puts a strain on the heart and increases blood pressure in the pulmonary arteries. She will need to undergo blood vessel occlusion at an estimated cost of RM25,000.

**8-months old Fateh Singh** was born with Transposition of the Great Arteries, a birth defect of the heart in which the two main arteries of the heart are switched in position. He will need to undergo an arterial switch operation at an estimated cost of RM80,000. His father works as a cleaner earning RM2,000 monthly and his mother is a housewife.



**11-months old Umar Faruk** is diagnosed with Ventricular Septal Defect (VSD), a birth defect where there is a hole that separates the two lower chambers of the heart. He is to undergo VSD closure surgery at an estimated cost of RM60,000. His father earns daily earnings of RM40 per day and his mother is a housewife.



**1-year old Adam Dafis Saputra** is diagnosed with Ventricular Septal Defect (VSD), a birth defect where there is a hole that separates the two lower chambers of the heart. He is to undergo VSD closure surgery at an estimated cost of RM50,000. His father works at a palm oil plantation earning RM1,500 monthly and his mother is a housewife.

**8-months old Khua Utha** is diagnosed with Ventricular Septal Defect (VSD), a birth defect where there is a hole that separates the two lower chambers of the heart. He is to undergo VSD closure surgery at an estimated cost of RM50,000. His father works as a contractor earning pay of RM50 per day and his mother is a housewife.



**6-months old Bibi Aisha** is diagnosed with multi-fenestrated ASD, PMVSD with aneurysmal tissue, discrete coarctation of the aorta, patent ductus arteriosus (PDA) and pulmonary hypertension. She will need to undergo operations for coarctation of aorta, VSD, ASD and PDA – all at an estimated cost of RM80,000. Her parents are unemployed.

**1-month old Hayfa Mawaddah** was born with Transposition of the Great Arteries, Tricuspid Arteria and Ventricular Septal Defect (VSD). She will need to undergo an arterial switch operation, with an estimated cost between RM80,000 to RM100,000. Her father works as a food delivery rider and her mother as a teacher.



**2-years old Alexia Marcel** is diagnosed with Pulmonary Atresia, VSD, PDA and Major Aortopulmonary Collateral Arteries (MAPCAs). She will require to undergo pulmonary arteries anatomy and repair surgery at an estimated cost of RM80,000. Her father is self-employed, and her mother is a housewife.

**5-months old Chervyn Lim Xin Ying** is diagnosed with Coarctation of the Aorta and VSD – thus will require to undergo surgery to repair coarctation and VSD closure, at an estimated cost of RM60,000. Her father works as a wood mill operator and her mother is an administrative staff.
